PRACTICAL INFORMATION

How to get from Paris to Orléans:

FROM THE AIRPORTS

- **Paris- Charles de Gaulle / Roissy (CDG)**
- **Paris - Orly (ORY)**
 - *General remark: If available flights to Paris - Orly might be more convenient, the airport is closer to Orléans and may allow for reducing travelling time, given the use of bus or an airport shuttle is intended.*
- Airport shuttle to Orléans/BRGM:
 - Reduced prices of the company working for BRGM: <https://pickme-up.fr/>, contact@pick-mecab.fr. You can book indicating that you are «working» with BRGM. There is possibility to mutualise to decrease the price of the shuttle. Please add in your request that you are coming as part of the Common Forum meeting organized at the BRGM in Orléans.
- Bus (blablabus or flixbus) to Orléans (but few hours available) 7 to 35€
- Public transport to Paris then train to Orléans
 - from Roissy (CDG) : RER B to « Saint-Michel Notre-Dame » then RER C to « Gare Austerlitz » 10,3€ + train ticket to Orléans (see above)
 - from Orly : Orly Val to Anthony, then RER B to "Saint-Michel Notre-Dame", then RER C to "Gare Austerlitz", 12,10 € + train ticket to Orléans (see above)

FROM THE TRAIN STATION IN PARIS

Take the train at Austerlitz train station and stop either at Orléans or at Fleury les Aubrais-Orléans (4 km from Orléans, more trains to this stop). From 21 € in 2nd class and 31,5 € in 1st class.

Both train stations are connected to the tram A which goes to BRGM and city centre (see description above).

How to get to BRGM from Orléans:

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

From Orléans-Centre, Orléans or Fleury-les-Aubrais trains stations:

- By tram* (line A, towards “Hôpital de la Source”) to the “Chèques Postaux” tram stop (trams are more frequent and regular than buses - approx. every 5 min.).
- Continue on foot (15 minutes), via avenue Denis-Diderot and avenue de la Recherche scientifique.

The journey from the train station will take 50 minutes to 1 hour.

From Orléans-Centre train station and city centre

- Take the train from Orléans-Centre train station to Saint-Cyr-en-Val (9 minutes ride), then continue on foot (around 20 minutes . The public transport ticket (TAO) is valid on the train (around 1,60 €).
- Take the bus n°41 (towards “ESAT Rodin, Orléans-la-Source”) to the “Paul Langevin” bus stop – at the moment it is not recommended due to construction works causing traffic jams.

For the 1st and 3rd of June the easiest way to join BRGM will be to take the train at Orléans train station with bus/tram ticket. It leaves at 9:12 (Train TER 861309, destination Bourges). The terminal to stamp the tram ticket is at the beginning of access to platform G. The train arrives at 9:20 at Saint-Cyr-en-Val.

Pick-up at the train station will be organised.
