PRACTICAL INFORMATION

How to get to Stockholm City Centre:

FROM ARLANDA AIRPORT

- **Arlanda express trains** depart every 10 minutes in rush hour, and every 15 minutes at other times between Arlanda Airport and Stockholm Central Station. The platform is underneath the arrival terminals. Travel time: 18 minutes. One-way ticket: 320 SEK; round trip ticket: 600 SEK.

- **Flygbussarna Airport Coaches** depart every 10–15 minutes between Arlanda Airport and the City Terminal (located next to the Central Station). Travel time: 35–45 minutes. One-way ticket: 129 SEK; round trip ticket: 209 SEK. Make sure you chose the right one – you want the “city centre” line.

- Commuter trains (operated by the **public transport company in Stockholm, SL**) to Stockholm depart twice an hour from Arlanda Central Station in Sky City. Total travel time between the airport and Stockholm Central Station is around 40 minutes.

Getting around Stockholm:

- **Public transportation** by subway, tram, bus, ferry, or commuter train: A single ticket is valid for 75 minutes, costs 38 SEK, and can be purchased at SL's ticket machines, through their app, or directly at the turnstiles using a credit card. It's also possible to buy 24 hours, 72 hours, and 30-day tickets. (See also [art in the subway](#))
- **Local boat transport**: a public transport SL Card includes the ferries from Slussen.
