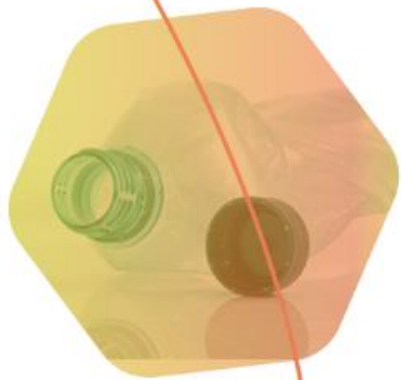

French Green Industry

- Draft law led by :
 - the Minister for the Economy and Finance ;
 - the Minister for Industry ;
 - and the Minister for the Ecological Transition.
- **Objectives :**
 - accelerating the reindustrialisation of France
 - developing green technologies and decarbonising existing industries



French Green Industry

- Priorities :
 - halve the time required to set up factories
 - speed up administrative procedures
 - increasing the resources of the services responsible for studying these files
 - clean up brownfield sites to provide pre-developed industrial sites
 - accelerated reuse of industrial land where industry has ceased to operate
 - 1 billion investment between 2023 and 2027 to create 50 sites (2,000 ha) of industrial land by cleaning up brownfield sites
 - facilitating the recycling of industrial waste
 - developing the circular economy and recycling channels
 - simplifying the use of recycled waste as a raw material
 - reusing production residues within industrial platforms

Contaminated sites in the French Green Industry Initiative

- Contaminated sites are directly concerned by Art. 5 and 6 of the draft law :
 - possibility for a “third party applicant” (land developer, public authorities...) to take responsibility for making the former industrial site *secure* (waste disposal, access limitations, eliminating fire and explosion risks, monitoring)
 - higher penalties for illegal sites
 - strengthening the status of environmental claims



French Green Industry : next steps

- This project has not yet been voted on :
 - Mid-June : subject to a vote by senators
 - Mid-July : subject to a vote by Members
- Similar guidelines that EU regulation « Net-Zero Industry Act » of the Green Deal Industrial Plan
